*Please read the following information regarding competition logistics

• IMPORTANT TIME & SCHEDULING INFORMATION

- Each performer is responsible for warming up on their own time and must report back to the Kresge Stage Door no later than <u>5 minutes before their audition time</u>.
- If auditions run ahead of schedule, *participants may be asked to audition early*.

• AUDITION MATERIALS

- o Participants must email a copy of their music to AUO Music Director, Dr. Jeffrey Klefstad, cmuauo@gmail.com by Saturday, October 4th, 2025.
 - Cuts need to be clearly marked and legible.

• AUDITION RULES

- o Repertoire Selection must be between 6 and 25 minutes in length. Any piece not fitting these criteria will not be accepted (see Application Form for Guidelines).
- Each participants will be given 20 minutes to audition.
 - Official time begins once the first note has sounded.
 - Participants should *cut 'interludes/introductions'* to conserve time.
 - If a participant exceeds the time limit, they will be interrupted by the adjudicators to end the audition (this will not affect the overall score).
- O <u>ALL movements</u> the participant wishes to perform—if selected as the winner—<u>must be presented</u>. We advise cutting sections within movements to conserve time. Participants may choose to audition with only one movement of a concerto, though this is not desirable. Jurors may ask participants where to begin
 - Example: Beethoven Piano Concerto No. 1 participant must present sections from each movement within the allotted time.
- o Memorization is not required, though it is strongly encouraged.
- This competition is closed to the public. This includes participant teachers.
- Accompaniment is required for all participants and must provide their own accompanist at their own expenses.
